**Leibniz-Institut für Analytische Wissenschaften – ISAS – e.V.**

What career options are available at non-university research institutes? As an example of how Leibniz institutes can provide excellent opportunities on the way to a habilitation, a junior professorship with a junior research group leadership or a career in industry, Dorit Günther is going to introduce **ISAS**. She will explain its role as one of 97 institutes within the Leibniz Association, and then focus on giving insights into ISAS's research concept and graduate programmes.

The Leibniz-Institut für Analytische Wissenschaften – ISAS – has two locations in Dortmund. ISAS develops analytical methods for health research. Thus, it strives to improve the prevention, early diagnosis, and therapy of for example cardiovascular diseases, autoimmune diseases or cancer. More than 70 scientists from the fields of chemistry, biology, physics and informatics are currently working together across twelve research groups in three interdisciplinary research programmes. ISAS works closely with universities in Germany and abroad, for instance through joint appointments. The institute also cooperates with national and international partners from science and industry. ISAS sees supporting junior scientists as one of its central tasks and has set up programmes covering all stages for a career in science.
